These condition reports are produced by our experts on a subjective basis and in no way constitute a declaration or guarantee that can replace the direct examination by interested parties or surveys obtainable only with technical / mechanical instrumentation.

All lots must therefore be examined adequately by the potential buyer or by professionals of his trust, in order to fully ascertain their status in a completely exhaustive way.

The lots are sold in their actual state and the absence of indications as to a defect or a restoration does not imply that such a defect or restoration cannot exist.

Cars, motorbikes and boats, as goods of a mechanical nature and use, are normally used and maintained, and, if necessary, repaired / restored during their existence. They are analyzed by the experts of II Ponte during the preparation of the auction, but II Ponte does not assume any guarantee regarding their state of operation, the presence of non-original parts or restorations.
